Reading

Glog

Use a glog to present a character from a favorite story you have read. Include a drawing, a brief bio, and a description of the character's importance to the story.

Digital Story

Summarize a favorite piece of literature as a digital story.

Blog

Keep an online journal of your thoughts, chapter by chapter, while reading a story.

Wiki

In a wiki with your classmates, compare and contrast different readings. This can be especially effective when contributors are reading different tales.

Writing

Glog

Create a character of your own and make a glog about her or him.

Digital Story

Use a digital story format to present a basic plot about the character described in the glog above.

Blog

Write blog entries in the voice of one or more characters from your developing story.

Wiki

Combine your work with your classmates' to create a wiki of interwoven characters and plotlines, all taking place in the same fictional world.

Web Site

Create an anthology of fiction and poetry written by your class and present it as a Web site.
