Reading

Podcast

Create a series of podcasts in which you read aloud chapters of a classic book (in the public domain) for other people's enjoyment.

Slide Show

Make a whole-class slide show promoting favorite books, with original illustrations and plot summaries.

Public Service Announcement

Design a public service announcement introducing people to features of your local library. Be sure to include hours of operation and contact information.

Video

Film a dramatic reenactment of an important chapter from a favorite book. Depending upon the book's length and complexity, you might condense the entire story instead.

Writing

Podcast

Write a script for a podcast in the style of an old-time radio mystery. Use sound effects to tell your story.

Slide Show

Use a slide show to demonstrate how to write a particular form of poetry. Include a history of the form. Examples might include haiku, tanka, sonnet, villanelle, or limerick.

Public Service Announcement

Design a public service announcement to promote writing pangrams. (A pangram is a sentence that uses all letters in the alphabet.) Be sure to include at least one example in your public service announcement.

Video

Make a video report about a recent writing competition in your state. Interview someone involved in holding or judging the competition, as well as one or more of the winners.

Grammar

Podcast

Record a series of podcasts discussing common errors in grammar and word usage.

Slide Show

Make a slide show illustrating how to diagram a range of sentences.

Public Service Announcement

Create a public service announcement for English language learners in which you identify the important irregularities in the English language.

Video

Make a video demonstrating appropriate formality in different situations—at home, among friends, and in school. Have fun showing how different levels of formality do or do not fit in each situation.
